LANDOW AND LANDOW ARCHITECTS AIA DESIGNS STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK MARITIME COLLEGE TODE HALL ENGINEERING LABORATORY SPACE

Monday, November 02, 2009 - Landow and Landow Architects AIA is pleased to announce its role as architects for the State University of New York Maritime College's Tode Hall Engineering Laboratories located on the College's 55-acre campus on the Throg's Neck peninsula in the Bronx.

Lead by Landow principal Glen J. Landow AIA, NCARB, LEED AP, the Landow team designed the renovations to enable SUNY Maritime College to achieve the institution's goal of creating modernized, state-of-the-art research facilities for students and faculty. The project includes a Fluid Mechanics Laboratory, Electronics Laboratory, Diesel Maintenance Laboratory, Strength of Materials Laboratory, Power Laboratory and classroom space.

Two of the laboratories, Electronics and Diesel Maintenance, are new facilities. The Fluid Mechanics Laboratory provides space for students to evaluate their own ships designs by creating scale models and testing them against water moving at varying speeds.

A separation was created between the existing testing space and the new Electronics Laboratory which houses work space containing electronics and computer equipments. A specialized exhaust system removes humidity that develops in the Fluid Mechanics Laboratory. The Diesel Maintenance Laboratory was designed within an existing two-story space allowing for a diesel engine, lift equipment, and student work space within a modern learning environment.

According to Glen Landow, "SUNY's goal for the project was to create state-of-the-art laboratory space to provide students with expanded learning opportunities within the facility."

The Landow team worked in collaboration with AKF Engineering who provided mechanical, electrical, and plumbing engineering services and Severud Associates who served as structural consultant. Landow and Landow has completed numerous other projects on the State University of New York Maritime College campus as well as Animal Research Laboratories at SUNY's Downstate Health Science Center.

Founded in 1874, the State University of New York Maritime College is an undergraduate and graduate institution focused on engineering, business, science, and maritime transportation, and is the first maritime school in the country.
